

Adult – ETDRS Eye Chart, Near Acuity, Amsler Grid

- If you have a printer, use it. It is easier with paper.
- Use these pages:



Child – HOTV Eye Chart, with Matching Pad

- Print the eye chart, and the HOTV Matching page.
- Use these pages:



- Check the circles to see that they are the size of a quarter. If not, you will need to make the circle bigger or smaller by adjusting your display. This should not be a problem if you print the charts.
- If you have room, set a chair ten feet from the chart, otherwise set five feet from the chart.
- If you have eyeglasses for seeing far away, use them when you test your vision.
- If you only use reading glasses, use them for testing your near vision.
- Test each eye separately by holding a Kleenex over one eye at a time.
- When testing young children, point to letters one at a time, and have the child point to the matching symbol on the HOTV matching page.
- Record the smallest line that you can see at least 3 of the letters reliably. If you are sitting five feet, use the scale on the left, otherwise use the scale on the right if you are sitting ten feet from the chart.




Near Vision Screener

Amsler Grid



Test under normal room lighting with reading glasses.

Hold the Amsler Grid 30 cm (12 in) from your eyes.

Test each eye separately.

Look directly at the dot with your uncovered eye and keep your eye focused on it.

Do any of the lines in the grid appear wavy, blurred, or distorted? Are there any dark areas or missing spots in the grid?
